

School Council meeting

School calendar – The calendar was approved for next year.

Kindergarten – Maximum number of students allowed is currently 30 from Reykjavik, we would like to raise this to 36 so we can have 18 in each class. That would then mean that we needed to have an additional staff member in the KG class and in frístund.

Question why we have a 5ára class. Explained that for IDL we actually start our school education with 5 year olds. But we do have a separate funding structure for the leikskóli aged children.

If we want to have a specialist 5 year old class we should charge more than standard leikskóli so they are paying for this extra service and for extra staff we might need. Anna Guðrún will talk to Ísaksskóli about what they do. She will also look into the official staff to student ratio expected for leikskóli age.

PISA survey - 25/3

Icelandic 10th grade will have this test on 25th. This is a long, computer-based test. Briet told us that the class haven't been told anything about this, Anna Guðrún is going to give information to the whole class and their parents.

Other business

- Someone will write letters to local businesses to see what we can get
